Mini Editorial

Last month a large number of Print entries were disqualified due to NOT following the rules for identification on the back of the prints.

Although the rules have been clear for many years on what is to be included and the placement of this information on the back of prints, this year categories have changed in N4C and subsequently for the Sioux City Camera Club.

The major change has been in the classification. For the upcoming 2006-2007 year the rules for entry into N4C has changed to Large Prints (up to 16 x 20 size including the matte) and Small Prints (up to 11 x 14 size including the matte).

The rules for marking the back of the prints are: The title and category of the prints and the makers's name and camera club must be on the back of the mount in the upper left corner. (Note: Taken from N4C Bulletin)

It was decided at the October 12 meeting to start enforcing these new classification and rules for the marking of the back of prints as well as a requirement that all old information be covered up instead of just marked out (as it was done in the past).

While these new rules are fair and we should be complying with the N4C rules for marking prints the NEW rules should have been placed in this newsletter before DISQUALIFICATION was carried out since NOT everyone came to the October 12 meeting. This was evident by the large number of disqualified prints.
